## RIGHTS OF MEMBERS

**U3A Bairnsdale operates as a RESPECT Community that is based on the following: -**

- Respect for others: -in encouraging participation of others in activities and discussion, respecting their views and ideas and accepting that all individual ideas or may not be accepted by others.

- Respecting the opportunity to learn by sharing skills and knowledge, taking time to listen to others and by allowing all to participate.
